#### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO TRANSFER AS A JUNIOR ARE:

- Complete at least 60 semester CSU transferable units with a 2.0 GPA (C average) or higher.
- Complete one course each from Oral Communication (A1), Written Communication (A2), Critical Thinking (A3), and Mathematics (B4) with grades of 'C' or higher.
- Complete at least 30 semester units of general education courses within areas 'A' through 'E' on this pattern with grades of 'C' or higher.

The California State University (CSU) General Education Breadth is a pattern of courses that California community college students can follow to satisfy lower-division (freshmen and sophomore) general education requirements at any CSU campus. Completion of all of the requirements on this pattern may not be necessary for all majors at all campuses. Students should meet with a counselor to determine the appropriate general education option for their transfer goal.

**CSU GE CERTIFICATION:** After completion of this pattern of courses, Contra Costa College may certify that a student's lower division general education requirements are completed for any of the 23 CSU campuses. Students are strongly encouraged to request a CSU GE Breadth certification prior to transferring. To request certification, students must check the appropriate box on the transcript request form and file it with the Admissions and Records Office. This certification can potentially prevent students from taking additional courses later.
