

2015-2016 California State University (CSU) General Education-Breadth

Approximately 124 semester units are required for a Baccalaureate degree at a CSU, of which 48 units must be general education courses distributed as shown below. Thirty-nine units may be completed and certified in whole or in part at College of Marin, and must include the completion of Area A and B-4. The remaining nine units must be taken as upper-division courses after transfer. California State Universities also require U.S. History, and U.S. and California State Constitution/Government for graduation. Courses at College of Marin that fulfill the two-course requirement are: One course in U. S. History to be chosen from the following: Ethnic Studies 111, 112, 121, 151; History 100, 117, 118 and one course in government to be chosen from Political Science 100 or 101. Students must make a request for General Education Certification through the Office of Enrollment Services.
