

San Joaquin Delta College is a two-year community college accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. The College is approved by State Board of Registered Nursing; State Board of Vocational Nurse and Psychiatric Technician Examiners; National League of Nursing; California State Department of Education; University of California State Colleges and Universities; Office of Immigration & Naturalization Service; Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

GENERAL EDUCATION (GE) OR CALIFORNIA STATE COLLEGE TRANSFER COURSES: Courses transferable to California State College or University campuses are identified in the GE column according to the area of placement.

CALIFORNIA ARTICULATION NUMBER SYSTEM (CAN): Courses that are accepted for transfer in lieu of an identically numbered CAN course at any other participating campus anywhere in California.

ACADEMIC RECORD SYMBOL AND GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CALIFORNIA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE 5, 55758): Grades from the grading scale shall be averaged on the basis of the point equivalencies to determine a student's grade point average using only the following evaluative symbols:

P	Passing (At least satisfactory - units awarded are not counted in GPA. Equivalent to a "A," "B," or "C" grade and units considered in probation and dismissal procedures), after August 14, 2008.	0
NP	No Pass (Less than satisfactory, or failing - units not counted in GPA. Equivalent to a "D" or "F" grade. No units awarded. Grade and units are considered in probation and dismissal procedures), after August 14, 2008.	0
IP	In progress. Indicated work is "in progress" and assignment of an evaluative symbol must await course completion.	
RD	Report Delayed. Assigned by Vice President of Student Services to denote delay of grade report beyond control of student. It is a temporary notation to be replaced by instructor's final grade. Not counted in grade point average.	0
MW	Military withdrawal. Called to active service in a United States military unit.	0

- 26 Repeat allowed/curriculum revision.
- 27 Petition initiated - No change to grade.
- 30 Basic Skills Unit Limitation Waived.
- 31 Legally Mandated Training Repeat.
