EXPLANATION OF TRANSCRIPTS

HISTORY

CREDIT

Sprand Community College is on the semester system and all units awarded are semester units

NON-TRADITIONAL CREDIT

Students may earn a maximum of 24 non-traditional credits. These units are not computed in the grade point average. Non-Traditional Credit includes. Credit by Exam. CLEP, Advanced Placement (CEEB), DANTES and Military Schools and Experience. Only CR/NC or P/NP (effective Summer 2008) grades will be awarded for Non-Traditional Credit.

REPEATED COURSES

If a course is repeated to replace a deficient grade, the units and grade points awarded from the first course will not be included in the cumulative totals. Prior to Fall 1977, a line is placed through the course that has been repeated on the student's transcript. Beginning Fall 1977, courses that have been repeated appear with a notation (see key below.)

INCOMPLETE GRADES

Prior to Fall 1981, incomplete grades remain on the transcript as "t" grades but are not computed in the cumulative totals. Beginning Fall 1981, an incomplete grade is changed to a letter grade if the incomplete is not cleared within one calendar year.

WITHDRAWAL GRADE

If a student withdraws from a class during the first 30% of the course, neither the course nor the grade will appear on the student's record. If a student withdraws from a class between the 30% and 62% date of the course, a "W" grade will be assigned.
