Ohlone College is a two-year community college accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Ohlone College operates on a semester calendar. One unit of credit is generally equivalent to one hour of lecture or three hours of laboratory per week for 18 weeks. An average load is 15 units. Full-time is 12 units. An associate degree requires a minimum of 60 units, including specified courses, and a 2.00 grade point average.
