EXPLANATION OF TRANSCRIPTS

HISTORY

College of the Siskiyous opened in 1957. The college is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

CALENDAR

College of the Siskiyous is on the semester system.

COURSE NUMBERS

1-49 courses recommended for transfer to the California State University system and all four-year Colleges and Universities.
50-99 courses primarily recommended for the Associate Degree.

COURSE REPETITION

Repeat (1) = Course retaken due to substandard grade.
Repeat (2) = Course retaken due to special circumstances or significant time lapse.

INCOMPLETE GRADES

An incomplete grade (I) will be changed to an A-F letter grade if the incomplete is not cleared within one calendar year.

WITHDRAWAL GRADE

If a student withdraws from a class during the first four weeks of a semester or during the first 20 percent of an irregular term, neither the course nor the grade will appear on the student's record. If a student withdraws after the fourth week of the semester but not later than the end of the 14th week or 75 percent of an irregular term, a "W" grade will be assigned.

ACADEMIC RENEWAL

The purpose of Academic Renewal (Section 55764 and 55765 of the California Administrative Code) is to disregard students' previously recorded substandard academic performance when such work does not reflect current demonstrated ability. As a consequence, Academic Renewal allows students the benefits of their current level of ability and performance and does not permanently penalize them for poor performance in the past.

COURSE CODES

Code A-E followed by a number indicates approved California State University transferable General Education courses.
ND indicates non-associate degree applicable.

ACADEMIC HONORS

President's List - Student had at least a 3.75 grade point average in a minimum of 12 units of graded work in a specified term.
Dean's List - Student had at least a 3.50 grade point average in a minimum of 12 units of graded work in a specified term.
Graduation With Honors - Student graduated with at least a 3.50 grade point average in all college work completed.
Graduation With High Honors - Student graduated with at least a 3.75 grade point average in all college work completed.

PROBATION/DISMISSAL NOTATION

Academic Probation - Student's grade point average fell below 2.0 in 12 cumulative units (A-F grades).
Progress Probation - Student failed to complete at least 50 percent of the 12 cumulative units for which the student registered (grade entries of W, I, NC).
Academic Dismissal - Student's cumulative grade point average fell below 2.0 for three consecutive semesters.
Progress Dismissal - Student failed to satisfactorily complete at least 50 percent of the units attempted for three consecutive semesters.
