Modesto Junior College is a two-year community college accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Western Association of Schools and Colleges and approved by the State Department of Education for training veterans. Modesto Junior College operates on a semester calendar. One Unit of credit is generally equivalent to one hour of lecture or three hours of laboratory per week for 16 weeks. Full-time enrollment is 12 units or more. The Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees are conferred upon completion of 60 units, including specified courses, and a minimum of 2.0 grade point average.
