ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The University uses the standard semester unit. Semester length is 16 to 18 weeks, except for Summer and Winter Sessions which are condensed. "Semester" and "Session" both indicate regular university (residence) credit. Effective Fall 1994, course taken through Extended Education have been incorporated as part of a student's academic record. Consequently, all students attending California State University Fresno and those attending through the Extended Education program are subject to the rules governing academic scholarship. REMEDIAL AND NO DEGREE CREDIT COURSES

Remedial courses are indicated by a course suffix which includes an "R", with the exception of the following courses: Educ 1, Educ A, Engl A, Engl AL, Engl 3C, Ling 3A, Math A, Math 1A, Math 4A, Spch A. Other courses which are not awarded degree credit include: CE 10, CE 193, ECE 193, IE 10, EI 193, ME 10, ME 193, Nurs 50, SE 10, SE 193. Additionally, courses with a Grading Basis notation "No Degree Credit" are either remedial, or are not awarded degree credit.

OTHER DESIGNATIONS

The following symbols in a course suffix usually indicate: L - laboratory for another course, T - topics course.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Transfer totals on the transcript include credit earned from those institutions and any Examination Credit listed. The abbreviation "ID" following "Degree Earned" indicates an international degree was the basis used for postbaccalaureate/graduate admission.
