 When a course is repeated, only the most recently earned grade will be computed in the GPA.

**Incomplete Grade**

An incomplete "I" may be assigned due to unforeseeable, emergency and justifiable reasons. The course work must be made up within one calendar year.

**Academic Renewal**

In accordance with academic renewal policy, units and grade points are not to be used to calculate cumulative GPA.

- \* The face of the document prints in blue ink. A different color indicates that an unauthorized copy has been made.
