In Fall 1967 Copper Mountain College began as a satellite campus of the College of the Desert, part of the Desert Community College District. Copper Mountain College began separation from College of the Desert in Fall 1999, completing the process in July 2001. As a result, some students who completed coursework prior to Fall 2001 may have duplicated coursework on transcripts from Copper Mountain College and the College of the Desert.
