

## **TRANSCRIPT GUIDE**

MiraCosta College is a semester-system, two-year public California Community College, officially accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

Courses numbered 100 to 299 are offered at the college level and are appropriate for the associate degree.

### **COURSE TRANSFER CODES (Beginning 1990)**

Prior to Summer 1990: Courses numbered 1 to 49 are intended as regular college transfer work to fulfill lower-division requirements at four-year colleges and universities.

Beginning Summer 1990: Transfer codes are listed after each course.

CSU: Indicates transferability to the California State University.

UC: Indicates transferability to the University of California.

CSU GE \_\_: Indicates subject area of CSU General Education.

IGETC \_\_: Indicates subject area of Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum.

### **HONORS COURSES**

Beginning with the Spring 2002 term, Honors Scholar Program Seminar, Honors Berkeley and Enrichment Seminar designations appear as a separate entry after the primary course. Prior to Spring 2002 term, "HSP", "E", "H", and "HB" designations are incorporated into the course description.

"HB" indicates Honors Berkeley for College of Letters and Sciences in English Composition: Effective Spring 1995.

"HSP" indicates Honors Scholar Program: Effective Spring 2000 term.

"E" indicates Enrichment Seminar: Effective Spring 2000 term.

"H" indicates Honors Seminar: Program effective through Fall 1999 term.

Founded in 1934 as Oceanside-Carlsbad Junior College, became MiraCosta College in 1964.
