To support your advising efforts and give you feedback on outcomes for your students, our Institutional Research & Academic Planning (IRAP) office has compiled the following resources for community college counselors. - [Fall 2018 CCC Enrollment](#) provides information on the total number of students who enrolled at UC and the number from each community college.
- [Undergraduate Admissions by School Source](#) presents data by average GPA of 2017-18 applicants to give insight on the GPA ranges students need to aim for to be more competitive in the UC applicant pool.
- [Transfer by Major](#) has detailed data including GPA by major, by UC campus and by specific community colleges for 2017-18. This resource also supplies data trends on applications, admits and enrollment by major.
- [Undergraduate Persistence and Graduation Rates](#) is a data tool that offers first year retention, and graduation rates of transfer students by community college. This tool informs counselors how well their students do once they enroll at UC.
