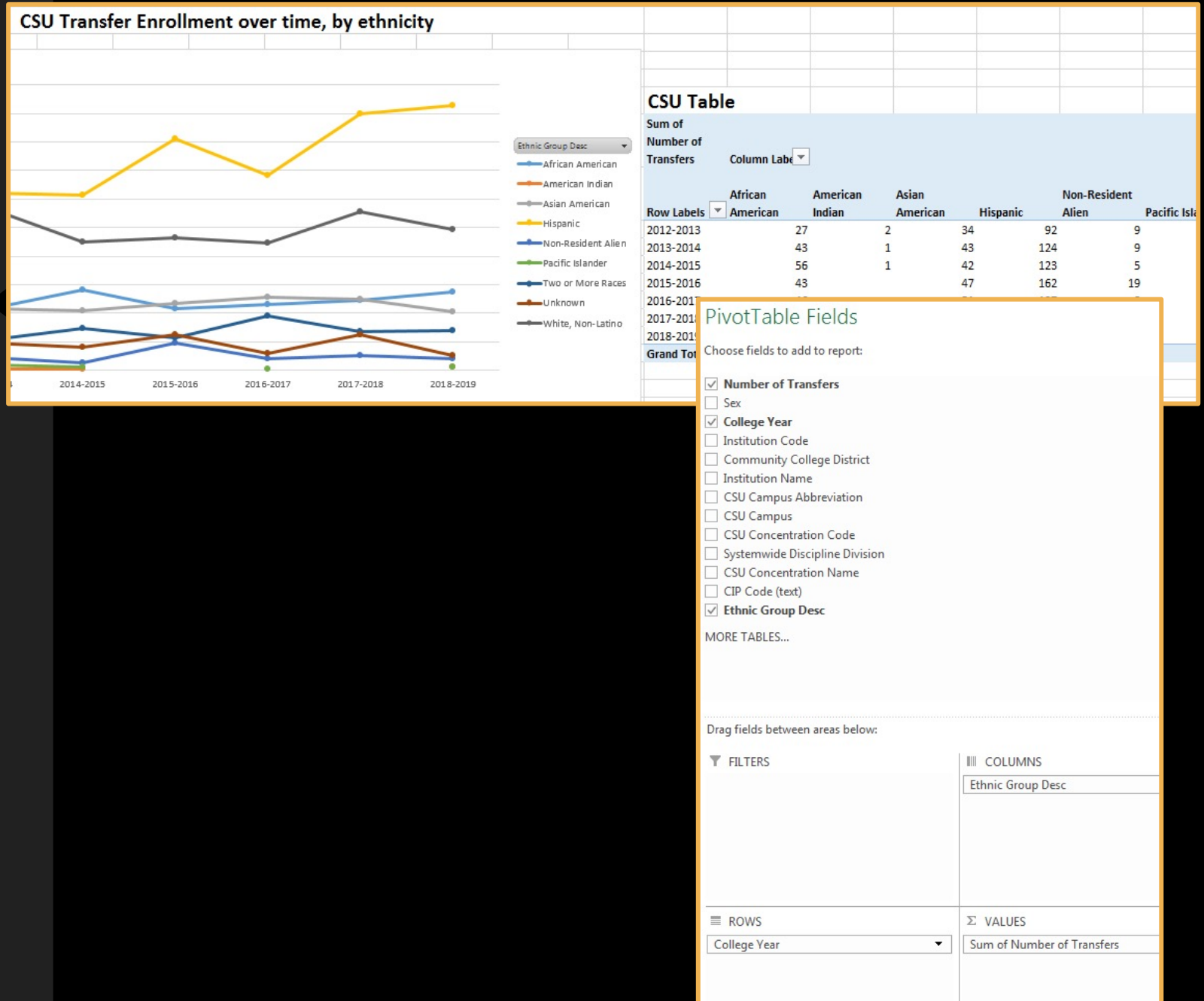

Excel Skill #2: Pivot Tables and Charts

Allows you to graphically summarize data and explore complicated data


1. Highlight all cells with information you want to look at (including column titles)
2. Press the Pivot Chart button under "Home" or "Data"
3. Drag and drop fields into "filters," "columns," "rows," or, "values"
4. If you want to be more advanced...
 1. Right-click on Values field, and change "Sum of" to "Percentage of" or "Count of"



Excel Skill #3: Percentage Sums

Used to answer the question-
“Are we closing gaps?”

1. Click into cell where percentage will be shown
2. Type “= (cell A)/(cell B)”
3. Drag from right corner of cell down to duplicate for all cells you would like to show percentages in
4. Are results showing as decimal? Highlight and right click on cells, select “format cells” and select “Percentage”



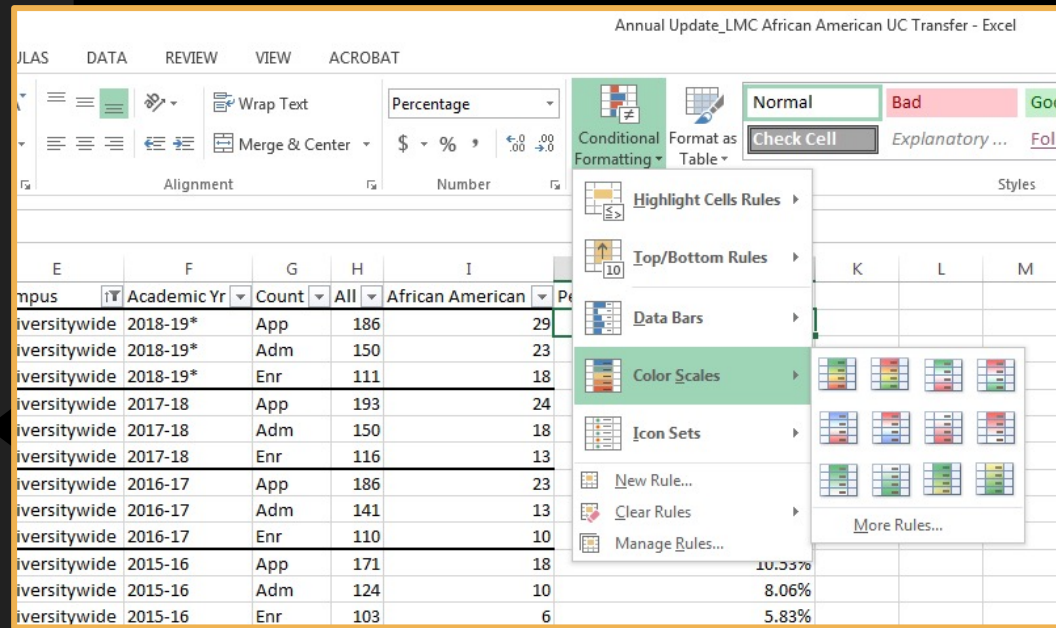

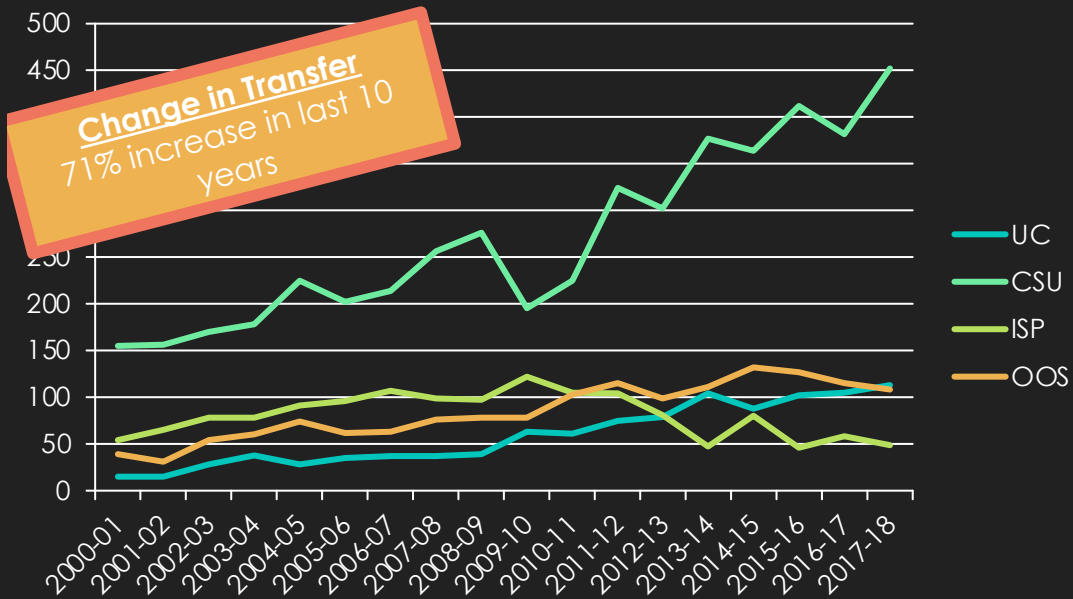
