# Excel Skill #2: Pivot Tables and Charts

Allows you to graphically summarize data and explore complicated data

- 1. Highlight all cells with information you want to look at (including column titles)
- 2. Press the Pivot Chart button under "Home" or "Data"
- 3. Drag and drop fields into "filters," "columns," "rows," or, "values"
- 4. If you want to be more advanced...
  - Right-click on Values field, and change "Sum of" to "Percentage of" or "Count of"



### Excel Skill #3: Percentage Sums

Used to answer the question-"Are we closing gaps?"




