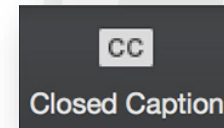

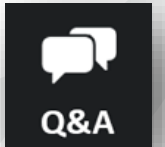

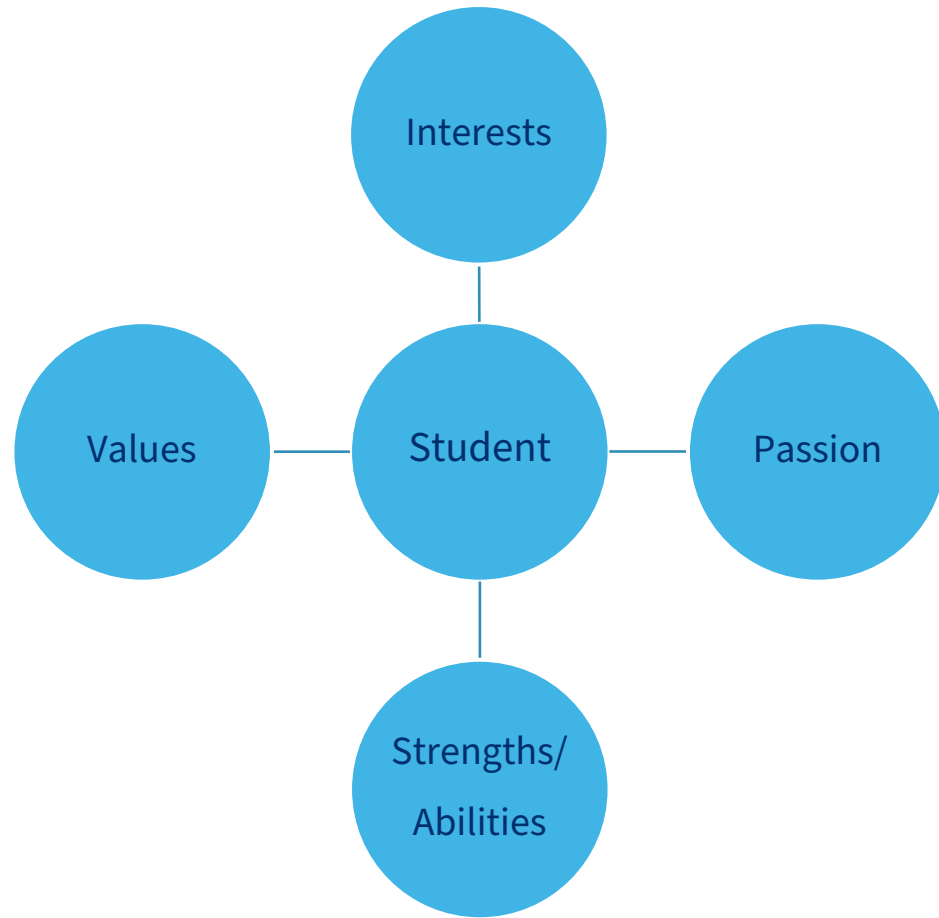


# Trends – Major selection & change
