Institutional responsibility for student outcomes

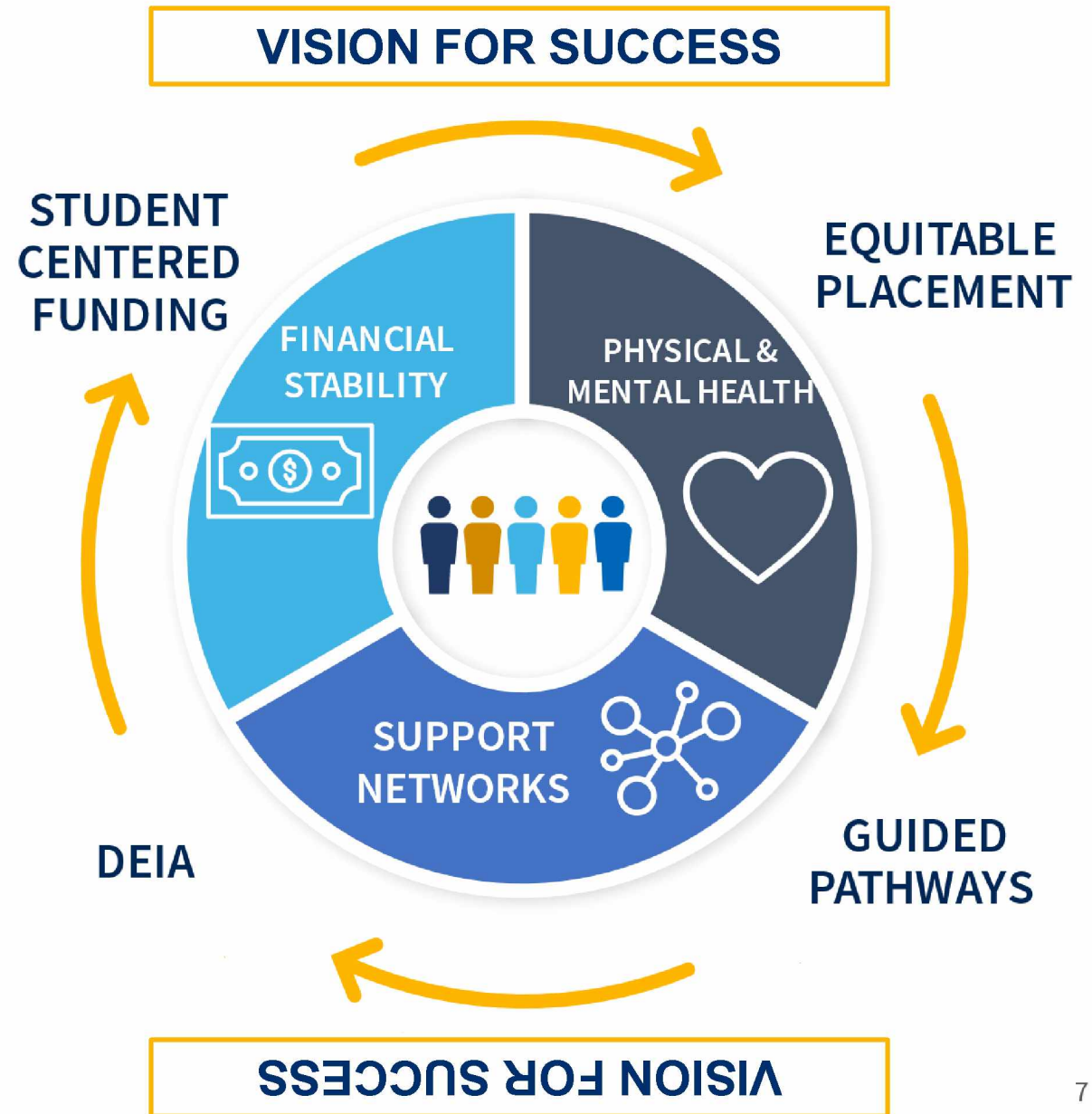


The “Messy” Reality of Student Experience
