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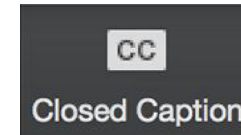

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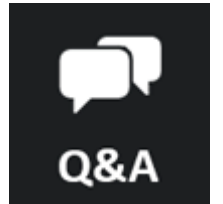

IGETC and Cal-GETC Patterns

The Intersegmental Committee of Academic Senates designed Cal-GETC with the following goals in mind:

- Unified GE preparation for both UC and CSU systems
- 11 courses and 34 units

Cal-GETC was mapped against IGETC (ICAS)

Some key changes:

- Area 1C Cal-GETC applies to both UC and CSU, and has been redeveloped as a new area to reflect that
- LOTE will not be included in the Cal-GETC pattern
- Lifelong learning will not be included in the Cal-GETC pattern

What happens to IGETC approved courses?

Patterns that will remain as historic lists and will be available for public view and reports

- IGETC
- CSU GE Breadth

Things to keep in mind

- CCCs will no longer submit courses for review in these patterns

Cal-GETC Submissions (1st round)

- Cal-GETC submissions in all areas are due by December 2024
- Courses should only be submitted for Cal-GETC (not IGETC) review
- The Cal-GETC submission, review, and decision publication cycle will mirror the IGETC submission, review and decision publication cycle (January – May 2025)

Implementation Plan and Timeline

Phase 1 (Summer 2024)

- Database and Curriculum area updates, IGETC > Cal-GETC data migration project

Phase 2 (Fall 2024)

- Workflow area system updates ahead of course submission and review cycle, Data sharing updates, Reports area system updates

Phase 3 (Winter 2025 - Spring 2025)

- Support of 1st Cal-GETC review cycle (CCC course submissions, system office reviews) and additional system improvements, Articulation area system updates

Public Go-Live (Summer 2025)

- Public Site (www.assist.org) updates - 2025-2026 Cal-GETC list is searchable

Catalog Rights and GE Certification

Cal-GETC is not required for the following

- Undergraduate students with continuous enrollment before Fall 2025 can follow CSU GE Breadth or IGETC.
 - Students who maintained continuous enrollment may elect catalog rights to complete general education and other non-major requirements.
 - Attendance in regular terms (e.g., fall, spring).
- Students with official transcripts indicating GE certification (e.g., ADT conferral, full CSU GE Breadth or IGETC certification).

Cal-GETC certification applies as follows

- New students beginning Fall 2025 and thereafter.
- Students without continuous enrollment or catalog rights.
- High school graduates who start at a community college Fall 2025 or thereafter, complete the Cal-GETC pattern.
- Students who have catalog rights prior to Fall 2025 may elect to complete the Cal-GETC pattern, but it is not required.
- Cal-GETC is only available for full certification by the CCC campuses (partial certification is not permitted).

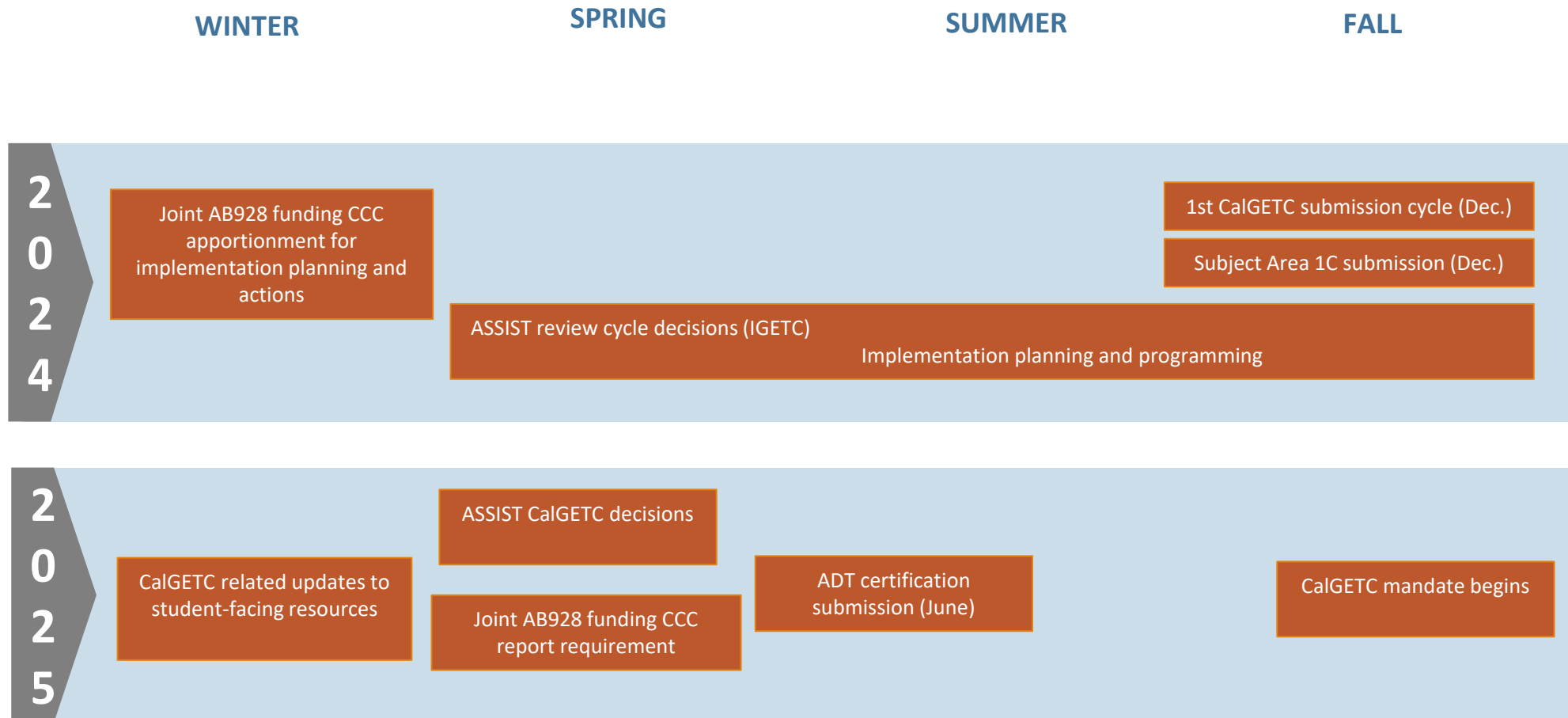

- Additional Changes Require Regular COCI Submission
- Leave Chemistry, ES, and ETE as is for now
- ADT Submissions to COCI Now | May Use a Cal-GETC TMC
