



#### **How many African-Americans are HBCU Graduates**

- 22% of Bachelor Degree Holders
- 40% of Members of Congress
- 12.5% of CEOs
- 40% of Engineers
- 50% of Professors at Non-HBCUs Institutions
- 50% of Lawyers
- 80% of Judges

HBCUs (37.8%) are doing a better job of graduating low-income Black students than PWIs (32%).1

"Prepared well for life outside of college"<sup>2</sup>

"Thriving in financial well being"<sup>2</sup>

Mentorship and strong professor relationships<sup>1</sup>

Engineering graduation rate – HBCUs 62%-92% vs PWIs 4%-8%<sup>1</sup>

Alumni are more likely to have a job or an internship in their field<sup>3</sup>


## ADT -> HBCU Alignment






